

Safety Notice To All Hebrew School Parents:

We would like to take this time to go over some of the safety rules for the pick up line when picking up our Hebrew School children:

- Cars must line up in (2) rows next to the orange cone.
- Please DO NOT pull up to the curb until the principal or another teacher from Hebrew School waves you to do so.
- Then pull up to the end of the sidewalk. (your children will walk down to you, don't stop in front of them).
- Please be courteous to other parents and alternate the cars from each line when pulling up to the curb.
- When parking and picking up. Please DO NOT call for your child/children to cross the street and come to you. *Go* to **THEM** at the curb and then take them back across the street to your car.

Sunday School Parents of Gan/Zeraim/Shorashim:

Please come INTO the temple approximately 5 minutes before pick up and escort your children out of the temple with you. (Because all of the classes are in temple on Sundays, there are a large number of children on the curb and the smaller children may get pushed or hurt accidentally at that time).

Please remember when taking your child out of class early, please see Cathy in the office to sign out your child and Cathy will call for the child. (When parents go to the classrooms directly, the classes are disrupted unnecessarily).

Your children are your pride and joy as well as ours. We just want to keep them safe. If we follow these rules we will be able to keep the pick up line as is, or we will have to reassess the situation for the future for safety concerns.
